ASSIGNMENT - You will be creating a collage in photoshop that showcases what you think body image means. You will be learning and using the basic photoshop tool to be able to do this project. You will be grading on craftsmanship and if it works as a collage. You can use ROYALTY FREE images from sites like

https://www.pexels.com/royalty-free-images/ or images from Pinterest.

Any additional questions you may have will hopefully be answered on this sheet. If not, reach out to me through your student email or during office hours as listed on the syllabus.

Q: I can't think of what to create it on?

A: You should think about how body image impacts you.

What influences your thoughts on body image? Who do you look up to what it comes to body image and why? How do you feel about your own body image? How do you feel about body representation in the media? If you could change how one views body image how would you?

Q: Where do I get Royalty Free images?

A: Input your search on *Google* then click *Images* then UNDER the search bar click on *Tools* then click on *Usage Rights* tab and then click on *Creative Commons License*. The images that are now shown are free images that will most likely require credit from the site you get it from. You will click on the image which should take you to the website where you will then click and drag the image you want onto your desktop from the given website. *FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS ASSIGNMENT YOU DO NOT NEED TO GIVE PHOTO CREDIT

Q: How do I download an image from google that's not pixelated?

A: Once you've input your search on *Google* and clicked Images, your going to go to the Tool tab UNDER the search bar and click on the Size tabe and click Large. This will only show you images that are large image files that mainly have a high resolution.

Q: How do I save a photo from Pinterest?

A: Once you have the image open you will click on the 3 dots(. . .) that are next to the image. A small menu will appear and you will click on the Download Image button. This will automatically download the image. You will then need to find it in your computer's download folder to be able to import it into photoshop.

Q: Can I include images of myself?

A: Yes you can but they have to be pre-approved by the teacher, NO INAPPROPRIATE IMAGES ARE ALLOWED AS YOU ARE STILL MINORS.

Q What if I want to use an image of a half-clothed person that I found online? A: NO INAPPROPRIATE IMAGES ALLOWED. Since this is a body image assignment, images of half-clothed people are allowed as long as the person in the image IS NOT A MINOR OR DOES NOT APPEAR TO BE A MINOR. Images of Tv show/ movie teenage characters are okay as long as the actor portraying the teenage character is OLDER. (NOT A MINOR)

Q: How many images can I use? A: As many as you like, a minimum of 10 images.

Q: Can I include self-harm images?

A: No, as it may be triggering for other students.
